The Lazlo Agency's "Seattle Branch" Warehouse and Offices

Ground Level: This 3,700+ square foot warehouse serves as the main storage building for the Seattle branch of the Lazlo Agency. It is supported by three rows of columns within the center of the warehouse, and has a loading dock at the front of the building. Since this warehouse is built on a small incline, the loading dock is elevated to accommodate any larger delivery truck, including tractor trailers. There are two bathrooms to the left of the roll up doors of the loading docks (under the stairs). Two staircases allow entrance to the 2nd floor and an additional floor entry is located towards the rear on the right wall.

This level also provides plenty of space to practice armed and unarmed combat, working out (including a weight bench, a treadmill and a Box Flex machine), a practice range for archery and shooting in privacy, and provides more than enough space for the library, various equipment, weapons, the "Demon Knight" van, and a large gun vault to store weapons and valuable items.

Second Floor: This floor serves as the administrative floor of the Branch. Includes a conference room, a break room, a file room, the executive manager's office, and a 2nd executive office (currently being used as the secretary's office).
